To respond to the COVID-19 pandemic, Mindrum Precision remains open and will continue production to meet the needs of our customers at this critical time. Our team will take the necessary social distancing precautions, CDC hygienic standards, and other active measures to ensure our workforce is safe and able to contribute to the critical infrastructure projects in Medical, Aerospace, and Defense. Currently, we ask customers place new orders as soon as possible, so that we can purchase all necessary raw materials, equipment, and tooling now so as to not be susceptible to supply chain instability issues in the future, should those arise.

In addressing the situation, our employees’ safety and teamwork is our greatest concern. With a strong diversified team, Mindrum Precision plays a vital role in several areas, including critical manufacturing, Defense Industrial Base, and Medical. We are doing everything we can to protect our team and continue forward. In addition to many internal measures that are being taken to minimize risks and exposure, we are also reducing site visitation to essential visits only subject to prescreening and written approval. We apologize for any inconvenience that this might cause, but we must protect our team, our customers and vendors.

For new and existing customers, in light of general uncertainty for materials or tooling availability, we recommend customers forecast their needs as far into the future as possible when placing an order. To ensure continued production of current orders, we have sufficient inventory for all necessary equipment, tooling, and supplies to function for a six-month period. Similarly, we are proactively ordering materials and tooling for work on purchase orders received even with delivery dates that are significantly into the future, just to remove all uncertainty from our own procurement process by having it done in advance. For this reason, if you anticipate putting in multiple orders this year, we recommend combining future orders and placing them all in advance to remove any uncertainty about material or tooling availability.
